

**For security reasons a locked gate has been installed at the boat ramp at SVL. We would ask that you lock the gate after launching your boat or removing it from the lake. This is a private lake and we want to insure that non-members can't have access. It also requires members to purchase their permits just like you.**

Please read the following rules of SVL/HVL and initial each one.

\_\_\_\_\_ All State of Kansas Division of Parks and Wildlife Watercraft Regulations rules must be followed on all Association Lakes.

\_\_\_\_\_ No limit on watercraft registered but members are allowed two watercraft on the lake at the same time.

\_\_\_\_\_ The maximum length for motorboats is 22 feet and pontoons 28 feet.

\_\_\_\_\_ No guest watercraft allowed on the lake

\_\_\_\_\_ Current permits must be displayed on the right rear side of the watercraft

\_\_\_\_\_ ALL traffic on the lake shall move counter-clockwise. Zigzagging or making unsafe sharp turns is prohibited. No watercraft operator shall cross the path within 100 feet of another watercraft.

\_\_\_\_\_ NO WAKE from sunrise to 10:00 am. NO WAKE after sunset daily.

\_\_\_\_\_ JET SKI HOURS are 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM ONLY on WEEKENDS and normal boating hours Monday through Friday.

\_\_\_\_\_ No wake speed must be maintained by all watercraft closer than 50 feet from the water edge and docks, including the boat ramp area and all coves marked by no wake buoys.

\_\_\_\_\_ No watercraft allowed in the swimming beach area.

\_\_\_\_\_ All operators of high speed watercraft are cautioned that sailboats, canoes, paddleboats and rowboats have the right of way.

\_\_\_\_\_ The Association Board of Directors, Manager, and Security employees have the right to suspend any member, or remove any watercraft from the Association lakes for up to 30 days at the time of the rules violation. Members who wish to appeal such action may present their reasons directly to the Board of Directors at any regular Board of Directors monthly meeting. Members who have been suspended from using the lake may be required to obtain and pay for a new permit.
